

If you are an international student, then you must have demonstrated your competency to teach in English. Consult Ron Stewart in the ESP office (993-3187) for more details.

TA's receive a fixed stipend (\$8175-\$9335/yr depending on experience) and typically teach 3 lab sections per semester. PTF's are hired and compensated on an individual section basis (matrix/lab section/semester) and teach 1-3 lab sections per semester.

TA's and PTF's will be selected based on qualifications in the subject matter and teaching experience. Graduate students must be making adequate progress toward their degree. Master's students awarded a TA will be renewed for a second year if they are making adequate progress toward their degree and have performed satisfactorily in their teaching. Ph.D students will normally be renewed for a maximum of four years under the same conditions. Extensions of 1 year may be made at the discretion of the Chair upon request of the student's major professor. TA's qualify for tuition remission up to 9 hours per semester (subject to availability of funds) from Departments tuition remission allocation. PTF may qualify for 4 hours of tuition remission as university employees.
