A minor in Environmental Science aids to give students an increased awareness of the major environmental issues affecting the natural world and society. The minor is intended to compliment a major in natural science but could also be taken by non-science majors.

and

GEOL 101 - Introductory Geology I (4)

3 credits of Applied Ecology

EVPP 377/BIOL 377 - Applied Ecology (3)

And a minimum of 8 credits of EVPP electives (of which 4 credits must be upper level courses). This minor cannot be taken in conjunction with the BS in Earth Science concentration in Environmental Science or the BS in Global and Environmental Change.
